

MSP® - PROGRAMME MANAGEMENT

Rambøll Project & Portfolio Management provides training for *Managing Successful Programmes* (MSP®). MSP was developed in England starting in 1999. It is based on best practices and is now the de facto standard for Program Management. In a Danish context, MSP® is the main source of inspiration for the programme management setup in the Danish central governance agencies.



Rambøll has put together inspiring and effective learning courses, where the blend of preparation and teaching is adapted and optimised to meet the busy work life of the typical attendee. The courses offer a strong yield, where strengthening the attendees' ability to translate theory into good practice in their own organisation is key. We have actively incorporated Rambøll's own experience with MSP® and program management into the courses. The courses also contain examinations, allowing the attendees a chance to obtain formal MSP® certifications.

The course consists of 3 - 4 parts:

Part 2. 3-day course ending with an examination and evaluation of the result, leading to formal MSP® Foundation. The course will be done in English to strengthen the attendee's terminology for the exam, that does not exist in Danish.

Part 3. 2-day course ending with an examination and evaluation of the result, leading to formal MSP® Practitioner. The course will be done in English to strengthen the attendee's terminology for the exam, that does not exist in Danish.

Part 1. & Part 4. held by Ramboll. The two parts are combined as a part of the overall course in order to strengthen the attendee's practical capabilities and relate the taught material to the attendee's own responsibilities and tasks. Participation is an offer and is not mandatory to obtain the MSP® certifications.

Time and place:

The next courses will be held in 2020 on **May 11 – 13** (Foundation) and **May 14 – 15** (Practitioner) starting at 9 every day.
